■ Drawings and sketches

The drawings or sketches have to be submitted in any form, paper or computer (in this case use eps, dwg, dxf or jpeg files). They must include at least 2 of the following:

- A block plan of the building, a perspective drawing or axonometry.
- Layout plan of the zinc roof or facade elements.
- Section of the main part of the roof or facade complex.
- Detail of zinc working drawings.

Clause 1

Umicore France with a capital of €23,175,000, located at 40 rue Jean Jaurès, 93176 Bagnolet, SIRET number 34296500100015, in partnership with personalities from the world of architecture and the building industry, is organising a FOCUS ON ZINC Trophy, the ARCHIZINC Trophy, from July 2005 to December 2005.

Clause 2

This competition is free with no obligation to buy and is strictly reserved for architects and design teams who work independently or who are employed by an architectural firm or design office. Employees of Umicore companies and the organisers can not participate.

Clause 3 Eligibility

Conditions for eligibility are as follows:

- Architectural projects with VM ZINC, roofs and/or facades,
- over 100 sq m of surface covered with VM ZINC,
- projects where the specification and installation of VM ZINC follow recognised good practice and VM ZINC recommendations,
- which were inspected and handed over after January 1st 2000,
- which have not yet been featured in FOCUS ON ZINC.

Clause 4 Obtaining application packages

Those wishing to register for the ARCHIZINC Trophy can obtain their application package:

- by picking it up at BATIMAT, construction trade fair in Paris (VM ZINC, Stand 54, Hall 1, Aisle G) from November 7 to 12 2005,
- By requesting it from the organisers, Umicore.

Simply indicating interest by talking to the Umicore representatives will not be considered as a valid application.

Clause 5 Registration of applications

Registration for the competition is effective on receipt by Umicore of the registration file with all the required information duly completed before December 31, 2005. A letter from the organiser, Umicore, acknowledging receipt of the file and its contents and assigning an identification number to the file will confirm acceptance of the application.

Clause 6 The registration file

The file will consist of the following, to be included with the registration material:

- The registration form completed in full,
- The reasons for the architectural choice for the project (optional)
- A selection of photos for the jury showing the architectural quality of the project and the areas covered in VM ZINC. These photos shall be in digital form (high-definition resolution).
- Drawings or sketches in any form, paper or computer (in this case use eps, dwg, dxf or jpeg files). These must include at least 2 of the following:
 - A block plan of the building, a perspective drawing or an axonometry
 - Layout plan of the zinc roof or facade elements
 - Section of the main part of the roof or facade complex
 - Detail of zinc working drawings.

Clause 7 Categories

The four categories to be judged will be the four building categories usually featured in FOCUS ON ZINC:

- Collective housing
- Individual housing
- Public Buildings
- Commercial buildings

In addition, there might be Special Prizes awarded by the Jury, for "Innovation", "Tradition" and "Sustainable development".

Clause 8 Choice of categories by candidates

The architects wishing to compete may choose their categories. Architects can submit one or several projects in one or several categories. However, each project must be submitted in a separate application file.

Clause 9 Composition of the Jury

The jury will be made up of 12 people who will be professionals from outside the Umicore Company. The members are:

- Dominique Boudet, former Chief Editor of the AMC, architectural magazine Le Moniteur Architecture, Chairman of the ARCHIZINC Trophy Jury, France;
- Jean-Pol Borremans, former Chairman of the board of the Belgian Conseil National de l'Ordre des Architectes;
- Dirk Jan Postel, architect, senior partner of the cabinet d'architecture Kraaijvanger Urbis, Netherlands;
- Jacques Fazilleau, engineer, graduate of the Ecole centrale de Paris, Chairman and Managing Director of the Société GEC, member of the building bureau at SYNTEC Ingénierie, Treasurer of the OPQIBI, France;
- Gilles de Montmarin, Architect DPLG, Deputy Director SEMAPA (SEM Aménagement de Paris), France;
- Lionel Dunet, architect DESA, member of the French national board of the

"Ordre des Architectes";

- Frédéric Borel, architect, Paris, France;
- Lluís Dilmé, architect, Estudi Dilmé & Fabré, Spain;
- Pierre El Khoury, Architect DPLG, Lebanon;
- Dimitris Kontargyris, architect engineer NTUA (National Technical University of Athens), Greece;
- Anik Schooner, architect, member of the "Ordre des Architectes" of Quebec and the Architects' Association of Ontario, Canada;
- Tomasz Markowski, architect, ECT - The Architect Company, Poland.

Clause 10 Selection criteria

The identity of the architects whose projects have been submitted will be kept secret, in order to ensure the complete neutrality and impartiality of the jury. Nevertheless, all the elements submitted must be clearly identified so that the dossiers remain complete. The jury will decide on the criteria for assessing the projects entered in each category before February 2006, the date set for judging the entries.

The criteria will be based on the use of innovation, the quality of the projects, and the creative use of zinc.

The decisions of the jury are final and no recourse can be sought against them.

Clause 11 Awards

The winners' projects and those of the runners-up will be highlighted in a special edition of the international magazine, FOCUS ON ZINC.

About 80,000 copies of this magazine will be published in September 2006 at the latest, and will be distributed to owners, architects and design teams in at least 10 countries.

If the organiser judges it necessary, in order to ensure the quality of the FOCUS ON ZINC magazine, a photo report of the buildings selected for publication will be carried out after the results have been announced. The organiser, Umicore, will be entirely responsible for the costs and fees for these photo reports. If photos submitted in the file are used, the copyrights for this publication will be transferred to Umicore France.

In addition, the winners will receive a work of art (the ARCHIZINC Trophy) to mark their success. They will also receive 200 copies of the magazine (100 copies for the runners-up).

Clause 12 Submission of application dossiers

The deadline for returning the application files is December 31, 2005.

Applications can either be returned to the VM ZINC stand or sent by mail before the deadline. The postmark will be proof of meeting the deadline.

The descriptions and items to be provided are listed in the application file.

By submitting these items to VM ZINC, the candidate accepts their unlimited use in all media (time and space) and for advertising or promotional purposes.

The items can be returned to participants at their request after the trophies have been awarded.

Clause 13 Announcement of results

The jury's decision will be mailed in February 2006 with an invitation to the winners and runners-up to attend the presentation of the trophies in May 2006.

Clause 14 Administration

The FOCUS ON ZINC prize, the ARCHIZINC Trophy, is managed by the Umicore France company.

The organisation reserves the right to modify these rules if necessary.

Participants will be notified in good time of any changes.
